Flavored coffees and gourmet cookies will be served in an Italian Sidewalk Cafe motif.

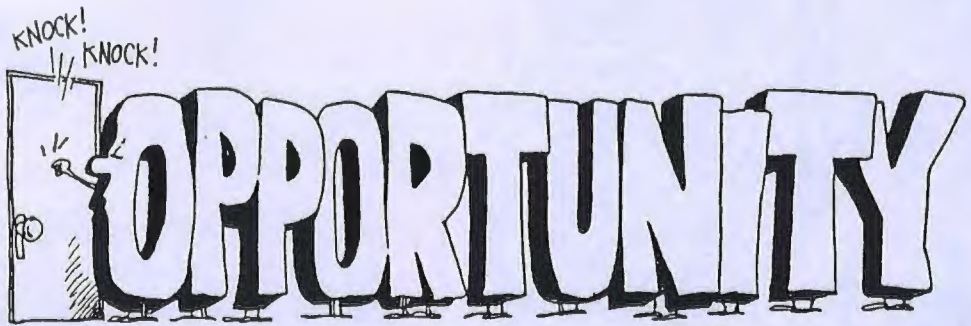

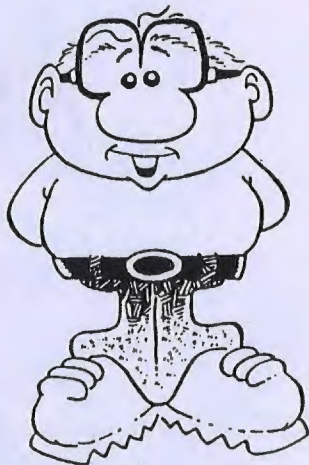
