The Artists

Kristin Grant is a Visiting Instructor of Music at Ouachita Baptist University where she teaches flute and music theory. Mrs. Grant is an active performer of solo and chamber literature for the flute. She has recorded for Klavier records with the North Texas Wind Symphony, and is a frequent clinician and adjudicator. She holds flute performance degrees from the University of Arizona (BM) and the University of North Texas (MM). Before teaching at OBU, Mrs. Grant was a member of the music faculty at East Central University in Ada, Oklahoma. Mrs. Grant and Dr. Hibler will be presenting tonight's concert as guest artists at the OMTA/MTNA East District Convention on November 6th at Oklahoma Baptist University.

Starla Hibler is an Associate Professor of Music at East Central University in Ada, Oklahoma where she has taught since 1991. She holds DMA and MM degrees from the University of North Texas where she studied with Joseph Banowetz. She received a BM degree in Piano Performance from Illinois Wesleyan University and has studied at the Vienna Conservatory in Vienna, Austria. She is active as a solo and chamber music performer and also serves regularly as a clinician and adjudicator. An avid performer of contemporary music, Dr. Hibler was the 1st Prize Winner of the Joanna Hodges International Piano competition's Krenek Competition in 1987. She is also an organist and serves as organist/choirmaster for St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Ada.
