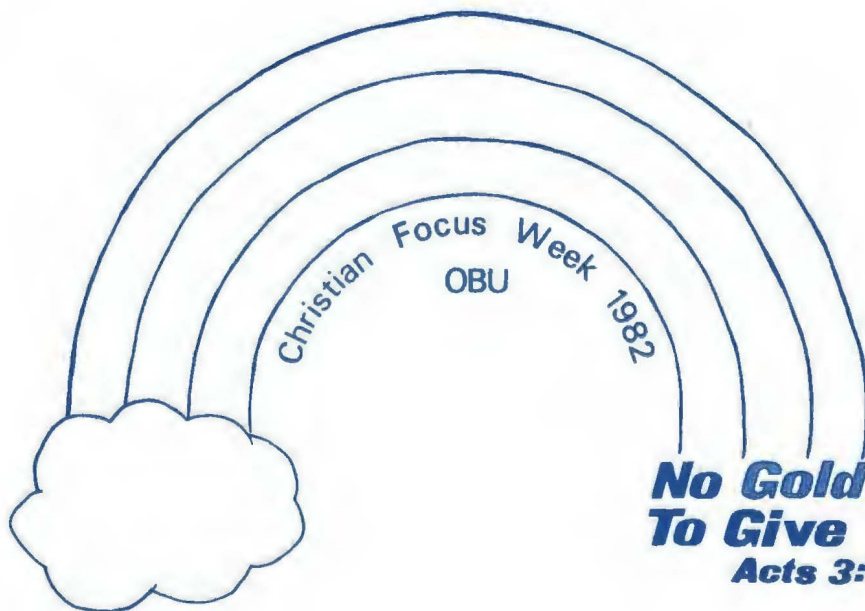

Now is the time to file your ACT Family Financial Statement for the academic year, 1982-1983.

Mr. Johnson has set May 1 as PRIORITY DATE again this year. This means that all forms must be completed, processed by ACT, & received in the Financial Aid office by May 1. As processing takes about a month, forms should be filed as soon as possible after your/your parents' income tax forms for 1981 are ready. Be sure to do this before April 1, 1982.

ARKANSAS RESIDENTS

State Scholarship deadline is June 27 - the ACT/FFS information must be received in the Little Rock State Scholarship office by then. Be sure to follow the instructions in the ACT/FFS folder for State Scholarship.

ACT/FFS packets can be picked up in the Student Financial Aid office during regular office hours.
