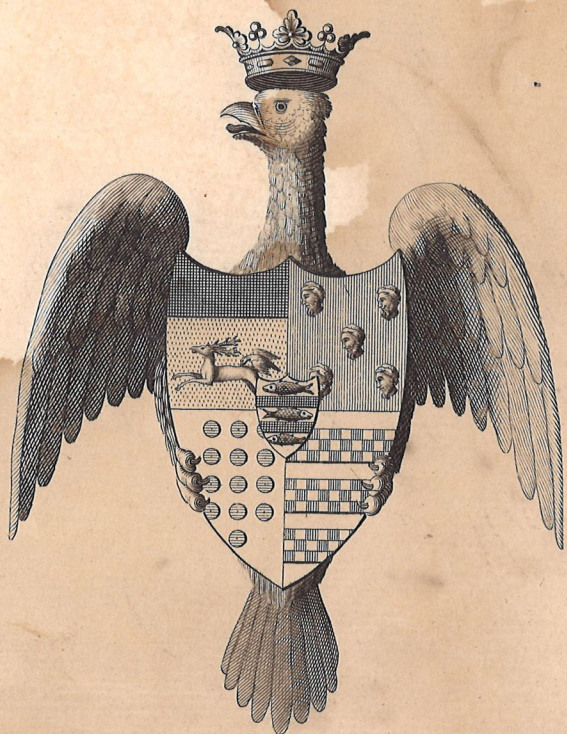

des (or Justices of the Peace) for the District of Secano Creek, which office you
are to exercise from this date untill the last day of the year one thou-
sand seven hundred and Ninety Three. Given under my Hand and
the Stamp of my Arms, and countersigned by the Secretary of this Go-
vernment at Natchez the Twentieth day of October one thousand
seven hundred and Ninety Two.
