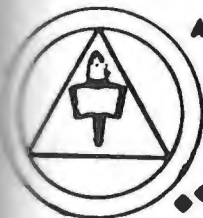

Student Aid

All of the scholarships awarded by Ouachita's Scholarship Committee require a yearly application for renewal. If you are currently a scholarship recipient and you have not applied for a renewal of your scholarship for the 1981-82 academic year, please do so at once.

Scholarship applications can be picked up in Mitchell Hall at Student Financial Aid Office.

Scholarships which were awarded for four years (University and Achievement) do not require application for renewal.

Applications must be returned to Student Financial Aid Office by March 1.

Nancy Cooper Scholarship applications are available in the Student Financial Aid Office. The scholarship amount will be \$400 for the 1981-82 school year.

Preference is given to young women who are (1) missions volunteers, (2) committed to church related vocations, (3) internationals recommended by a Southern Baptist Missionary.

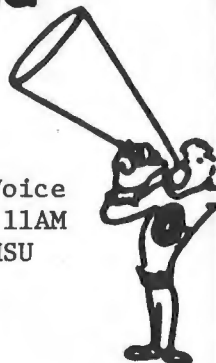
