The humble Petition of Melling Woolley
Sheweth

That your Pet^r. became Security
to W. Mellen Varsden for a Mrs Brown family
of the Iy. Ou. Puna but now of the Iy. Puna in
a Considerable Am^t. abt. 200 Dollars is yet Unpaid
W. Varsden Now pushes your Pet^r. Very hard to
discharge his Obligation, Said Brown left in your
Pet^r. hands a Patent for a tract Land on the
Iy. Ou. Puna on which the Said Brown family
lived, as a Collateral Security & also some other Lands
that was engag^d to be Made Over to him by the
Executors of Ralph Humphries, but which is Not
yet Done, y^e. Pet^r. is desirous to have done with this
business, & has y^e. Now by him Ordres from Said Brown
to Sell the whole of his Land, & pay this debt.

your Pet^r. Prays your Excell^y. will Order
the Executors of Ralph Humphries immediately
to full fill their engagement to Said Brown,
after which your Pet^r. will further Proceed, as your
Excell^y. may direct, respecting the Sale of the whole
Property, to discharge the Obligations your Pet^r.
