 make no charges for his work - & since

Assn. Troubles W.A.P.

1976 Charges brought against one Whit
for being a ch. of excluded members - and
Churches recommended to have no fellowship
with said Ch. or pastor - or members bapt. by him
seems to have done till 1979 - when -

1979 A resolution was adopted - making declaring
Walt & others responsible to their own ch.
for neglect of duty or abuse of privileges.

At this Assn it seems that J.M. Hatley
was under fire about his Times or Times 8,
but he made a satisfactory statement and cleared.

1890 F.J. Kregel - Sheets Mission - Messengers ask to sit
specific article from ch. and send to St. board.

1892 A court report adopted that one bapt. Ch.
does not have a right to receive an excluded
member from another Ch.

1899. Barkok, was advised to withdraw
fellowship from loose Denarians,
quoting mat 5:22, Mat. 19:9
