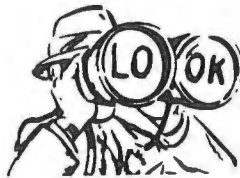

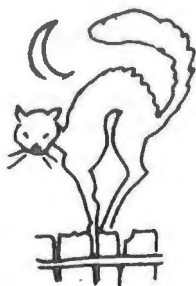
SHADOW
