# What Is OSF?

**The Ouachita Student Foundation is a student-led organization founded in 1974 with the mission of “students helping students.” As ambassadors and advocates for the student body, members of OSF strive to meet the needs of their peers through scholarship-raising and service efforts.**

OSF sponsors various campus events throughout the school year. In the fall, the organization plans Tiger Tunes, which you are experiencing tonight. Each spring, OSF hosts Tiger Traks, a multi-faceted field-day in which students compete in events like egg toss, basketball relay, dodgeball, raft races in Waggoner Pool, Oozeball (mud volleyball) and mud tug-o-war. In addition to these flagship fundraising events, members also call OSF alumni to ask for scholarship gifts and serve concessions at home football games, receiving a portion of the proceeds to give back to their fellow students.

Since 1974, OSF has raised more than \$1.5 million in scholarships for students. Just by attending tonight, you are joining with OSF's current members to provide more than \$100,000 in scholarships to their fellow students, helping juniors and seniors stay and complete their degrees at Ouachita. 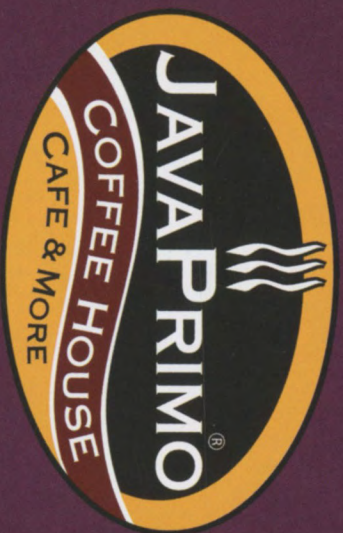
