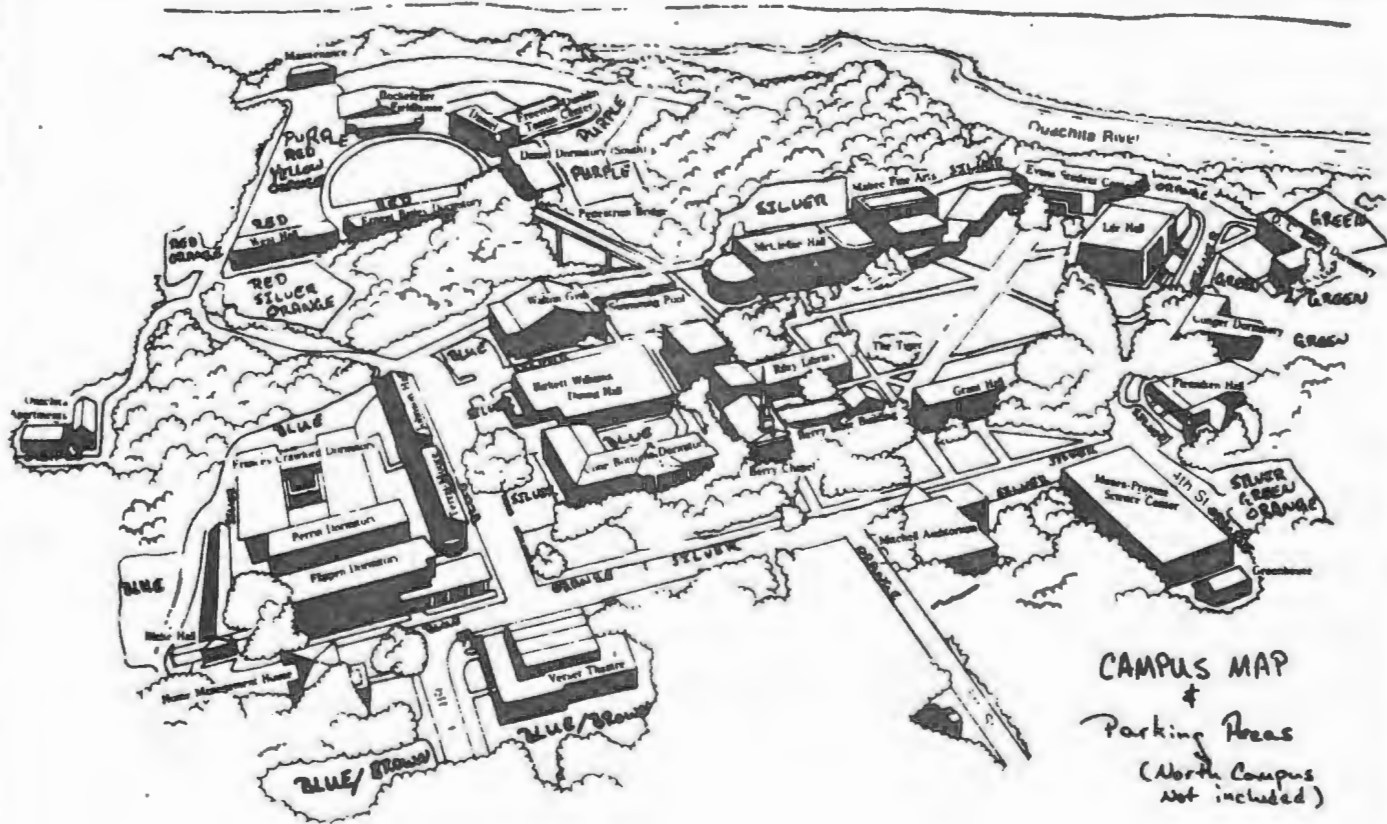


SCHOLARSHIPS

These include university and noninstitutional scholarships which are listed in the current OBU catalog.

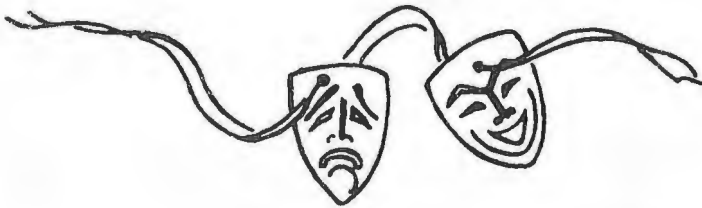
Scholarship applications are available from the Office of Student Aids.

ART CONTEST

HSU and OBU will join forces for "Arkansas on Exhibit," an art competition offering some of the richest art awards in the state's history.

The competition is open to all artists now working in Arkansas.

Awards in the show will include a \$1,000 "Best of Show" purchase prize, a \$700 purchase prize, four \$200 third-place awards and five \$100 "honorable mention" prizes. Entries in prints, drawings, paintings, drawings, crafts, and photographs may be submitted.

Preliminary judging will be done from 35mm slides, to be received by contest officials no later than Jan. 25, 1980. Entry fees required from each competing artist are \$5 for the first submitted work and \$2.50 for each additional work. Artists may enter three works in any category of competition.

All works entered in the competition must be recent works done by the artist without the assistance or guidance of a professional art instructor.
