The Artists

Barry McVinney, Assistant Professor of woodwinds at Ouachita Baptist University, holds graduate degrees in flute performance from The University of Texas and the University of Nebraska. He has toured the US and Canada with several Broadway shows and continues to be in demand as a jazz and classical musician.

Diane McVinney, is second flutist with the Arkansas Symphony and principal flutist with the Pine Bluff Symphony. Her graduate work led to a Performance Certificate in Chamber Music from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and a Master of Music Degree in flute performance from The University of Texas at Austin. Ms. McVinney has taught flute privately, in college and secondary school settings, and has performed frequently as a chamber musician.

Erica McClellan completed her Master of Music degree in piano performance in may of 1997 at the Peabody Conservatory where she studied with Ann Schein. She earned a Bachelor of Music degree, also in piano performance, from the University of Maryland, College Park, studying with Anne Koscielny. Currently Ms. McClellan teaches piano at OBU and is a free-lance accompanist and piano teacher in Arkadelphia.
