MINISTERIAL ASSOCIATION

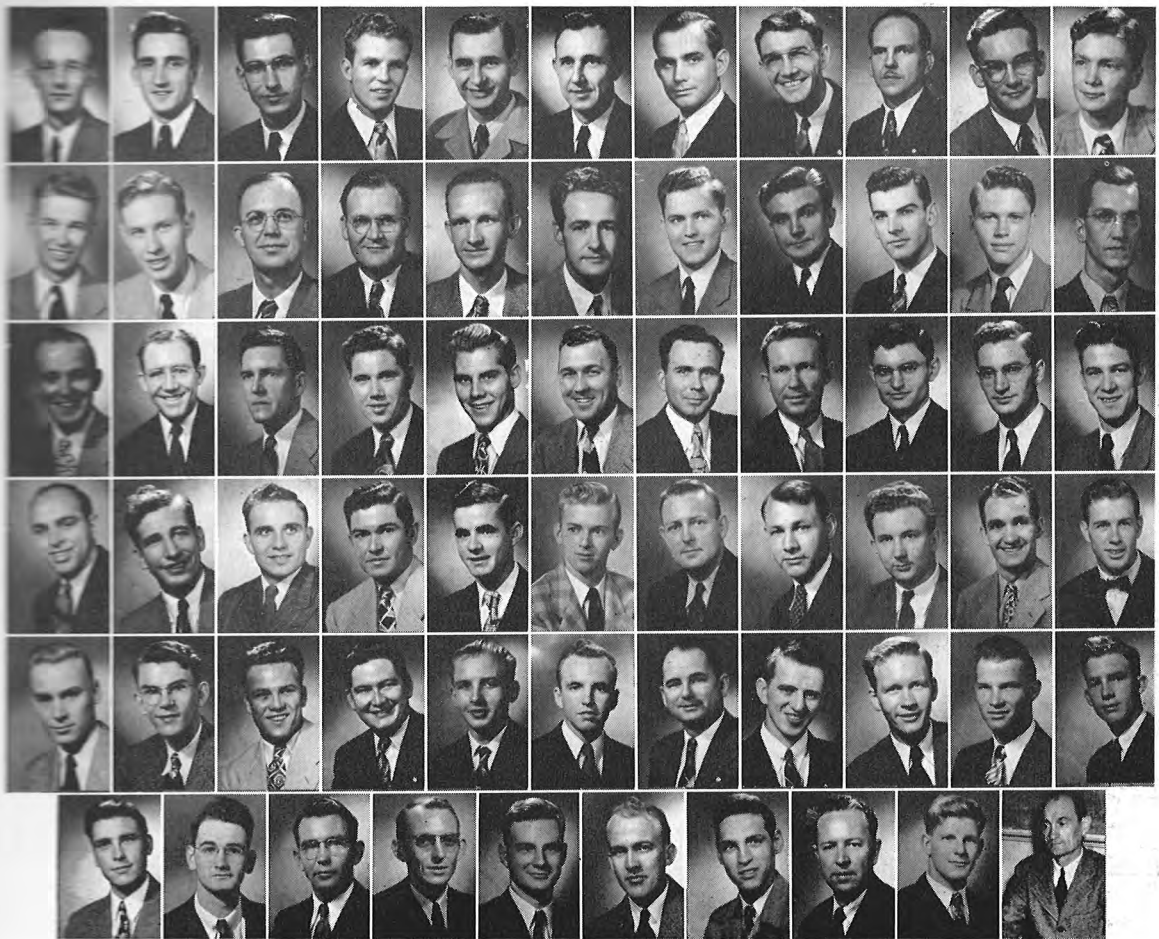

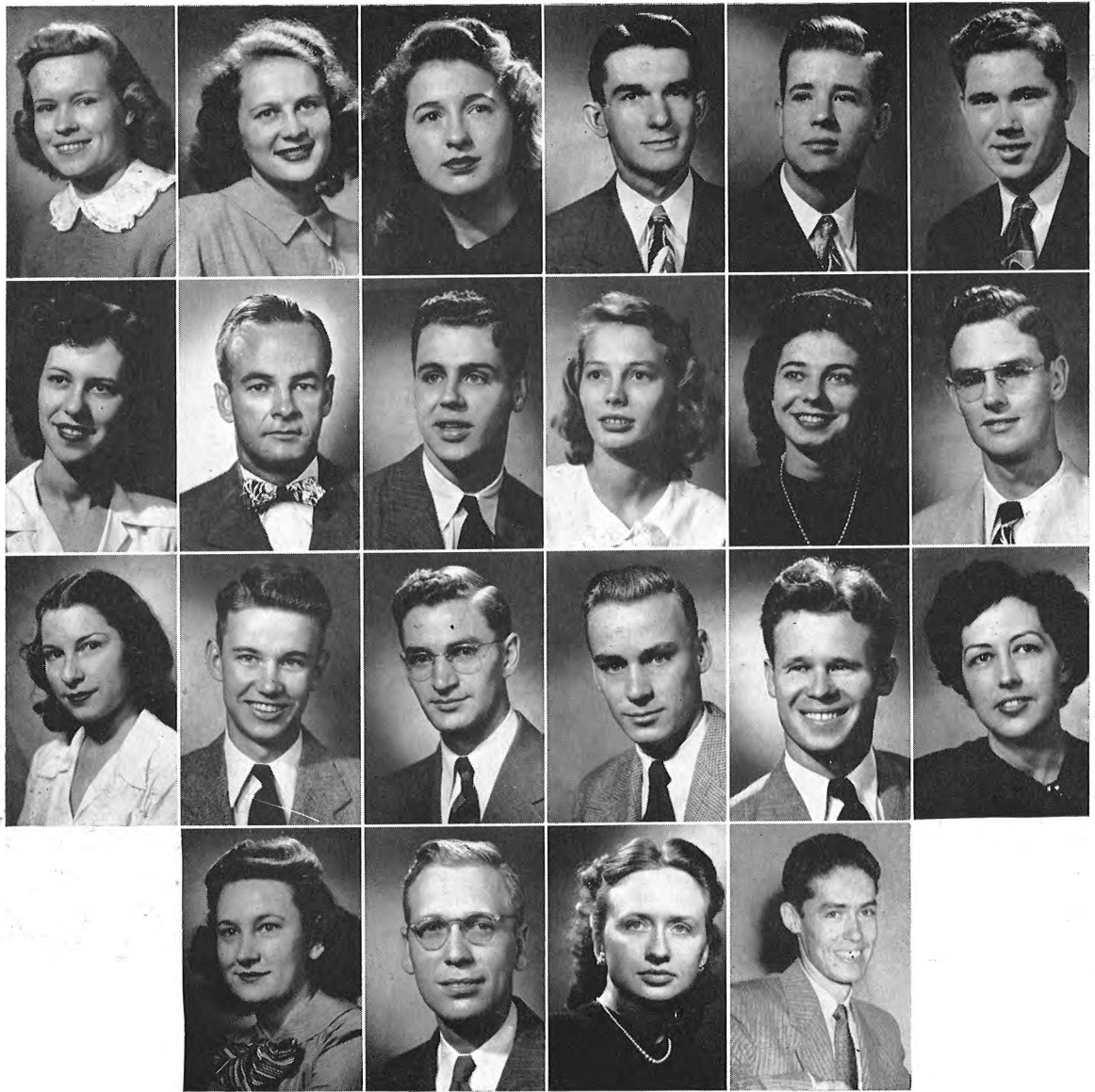
