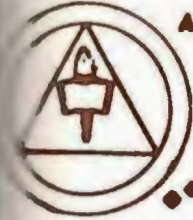

Student Aid

At the close of Chapel, January 27, copies of the new ACT FFS will be handed out to any student wishing to apply for financial aid for the school year 1981-82, and/or the second summer session, 1981.

These forms are based on the 1980 income figures.

The financial aid office has set a priority date of May 1, 1981. Those students whose financial aid reports have been received by that date will receive first priority on available funds.

The State Scholarship application for 1981-82 must be received in the State Scholarship office by June 27, 1981. Please allow four to six weeks for processing. To be sure of meeting this deadline your ACT FFS must be mailed by May 16, 1981.

The Student Life Committee requests that all drivers proceed with excess caution when approaching the crosswalk between the pedestrian bridge and the swimming pool.

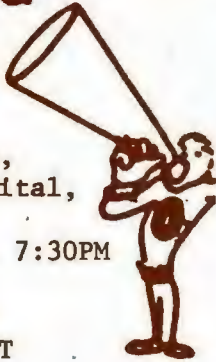


If you are a new student, you may have your ID made in the AV section of the library. If you need your ID replaced, get a replacement slip from the Bus. Office then take it to AV.
