## The Artist

Erica Godshall McClellan completed her Masters degree in piano performance at the Peabody Conservatory in May of 1997, where she studied with Ann Schein. She earned a Bachelor of Music degree, also in piano performance, from the University of Maryland, College Park, studying with Anne Koscielny.

Ms. McClellan has performed for the National Federation of Music Clubs National Convention, the Sigma Alpha Iota National Convention, the Arts Club of Washington and the Pennsylvania Academy of Music, as well as giving benefit concerts for the National Women's (composers) Symphony and the Musical Art Society of Lancaster, PA. She has been soloist with the Lancaster Symphony and the Holton-Arms Orchestra, Washington, D.C.

In 1996, Ms. McClellan was awarded the Verna Ross Orndorff Career Performance Grant by Sigma Alpha Iota. She also won the National Society of Arts and Letters Piano Competition, the Sigma Alpha Iota National Undergraduate Audition, the Mu Phi Epsilon Undergraduate Competition and was a University of Maryland Senior Scholar.

Currently, Ms McClellan is teaching at OBU, giving private lessons and doing free-lance accompanying in Arkadelphia.
