Francis McBeth Recital Hall Mabee Fine Arts Center Dr. John Barcellona is the Director of Woodwind studies and Professor of Flute in the Bob Cole Conservatory of Music at CSULB. He raises scholarship funds for his programs by running marathons, which number 70 to date. His efforts have raised more than \$100,000 over the last 25 years.

He is a flutist with the Westwood Wind Quintet, a member of the Caliendo Trio and has numerous recordings. He also teaches doctoral students at Claremont Graduate University and plays in Concordia Clairmontis, the faculty Baroque Ensemble.

He is an active freelance musician in the Southern California area and has recorded for film scores. In May of 2014, he was a guest artist at the 29th annual International Flute Festival in Lima, Peru. He is a consultant for the Miramatsu Flute Company and has designed the Barcellona Model Kori Flute. The seminar is sponsored in part by a grant from Muramatsu America.

Dr. Barcellona received his B.M. from Hart School of Music, M.A. from CSULB and D.M.A. from USC. His principal teachers were Harold Bennett (NY Metropolitan Opera), Carl Bergner (Hartford Symphony), Roger Stevens (Los Angeles Philharmonic) and John Wummer (New York Philharmonic).

Dr. Adam Haas earned his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in piano performance at the University of Colorado, where he also served as a graduate teaching assistant. He has performed with the New York Concerti Sinfonietta, the Loveland Orchestra and the Colorado State University Orchestra; has been featured in chamber performances with the Fort Collins Chamber Players and the Colorado State University Chamber Orchestra; and has presented at numerous conferences at the national and state level. Haas has also earned degrees from Indiana University and Colorado State University and has studied and performed at the Aspen Music Festival and the New Orleans Piano Institute. He joined Ouachita's faculty in 2012.
