Students are reminded that the priority date for filing ACT Family Financial Statements (FFS) is May 1, 1985 for the 1985-86 school year. For those who file after May 1, financial aid will be awarded on a pro rata basis to the extent that funds are available. FFS packets are available from the Financial Aid Office.

Students are reminded that they must enroll in and remain enrolled in at least 12 hours to receive most forms of financial assistance. Dropping to less than 12 hours will result in the loss of some forms of aid and a reduction in the amount for others. The last day to add hours is January 29th.

STAR WARS

The "Star.Wars" weapons system now being developed by the United States military will be the focus of an audiovisual presentation and public discussion in the Verser Drama Center at Ouachita Baptist University on Wednesday, January 30, from 3:00 to 4:00 pm.

Officers from the Air Force Space Command (AFSC) in Colorado Springs, Colorado, will head the program. Discussion will not be confined to the "Star Wars" concept but will also cover the entire mission of the newly-established AFSC.

The AFSC's involvement with space systems includes management of four major satellite systems, three bases, four Air Force stations and 22 world-wide space and missile warning sensors.

The Space Command's appearance in Arkadelphia resulted from an invitation by Ouachita graduate and Air Force General Lewis Lile (Ret.) of Hot Springs. Admission is free and open to the public.
