## Verse I. Choral Fantasia

Christ unser Herr zum Jordan kam nach seines Vaters Willen, von Sanct Johanns die Taufe nahm, sein Werk und Amt zu erfüllen. Da wolt' erwetiften uns ein Bad zuwaschen uns von Sünden, ersäufen auch den bittern Tod durch sein selbst Blut und Wunden; es galt ein neues Leben.

#### Bass aria

Merkt und hört, ihr Menschenkinder, was Gott selbst die Taufe heisst. Es muss zwar hier Wasser sein, doch schlecht Wasser nicht allein, Gottes Wort und Gottes Geist tauft und reiniget die Sünder.

Christ our Lord came to the Jordan according to his Father's will, took baptism from Saint John to fulfill his work and duty. Since he wished to prepare us a bath to wash us of our suns, also to drown bitter death through his own blood and wounds; which is worth a new life.

Mark and hear, ye human children, what God himself call baptism. There must, of course be water, but not only mere water, God's Word and God's Spirit baptize and purify the sinner.

This has God clearly proven with words and illustrations, the Father manifestly let voice be heard at the baptism of Christ; He spoke: This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased, He came from highest Heaven's throne for the world's sake in a humble form and has assumed the flesh and blood of human children.

Receive Him now as your Saviour and hear His dear teachings.
