Lecture

The JEC of Arkadelphia will present Dr. Vladimir N. Sakharov, former member of the KGB and an expert on U.S.-Soviet relations, in a public address on Tuesday, February 11, at 7:30 p.m. in the Recital Hall of MFAC at OBU. There is no admission charge. Sakharov's presentation at OBU is entitled "Conformity Versus Dissent." He is the third speaker of the current joint lecture series on "Cultural Roots and Continuities" offered through the JEC by OBU and HSU. A Soviet-trained diplomat whose disillusionment with the KGB led him to become an agent for the U.S., Sakharov is now a citizen of this country. He holds a Ph.D. degree in international relations. He is the author of the highly acclaimed book, High Treason, and numerous articles on intelligence and the new Sovietelite. He was a member of the Soviet intelligence force from 1967 to 1972.
