1. No pledging activities are to take place before the Sunday night (8:30 p.m.) meeting which is required of all pledges, pledge masters & pledge mistresses, and club presidents. All members are welcome to come.
2. In the cafeteria, nothing is to interfere with normal activities. Pledges are not to carry trays, get seconds, nor run errands for anyone other than themselves. Pledges are not to stand on tables, chairs, etc. or otherwise distract from the pleasantness of mealtime.
3. Any type of object carried by the pledge is to be left outside the classrooms, chapel, noonday, etc.
4. Dressing up is limited to after 5:00 p.m. each day and only on Thursday, however, the dress is not to be offensive, larger than the body or of such a nature that it will distract from normal activities.
5. All pledging activities with both members and pledges present are to have two faculty sponsors present. Faculty wives, graduate students and secretarial staff will not be acceptable.
6. The broad guidelines set the hours of pledging from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.. If activities are approved to begin earlier than 7:00 a.m., the equivalent time is subtracted that evening. In any case, ALL PLEDGING ACTIVITIES are to stop at 11:00 p.m. or before, and all pledges are to be in their room at the designated time for that day.
7. No pledge is to miss class or campus work during pledge week.
8. No foodstuff or anything is to be placed on or in the mouth. Clubs are allowed to use only items approved by the Pledging Committee and a list of these will be in the hands of the sponsors.
9. No pledge is to sit on ice.
10. Inactive members or former members have no authority over pledges during pledge week. Any violation of this should be reported to the Dean of Students or Pledge Committee.
11. Pledging activities are not to take place outside Berry Bible Building Chapel prior to or following noonday services. These activities should be held at the Tiger. As you enter noonday, remember that one should be in an attitude of Worship.

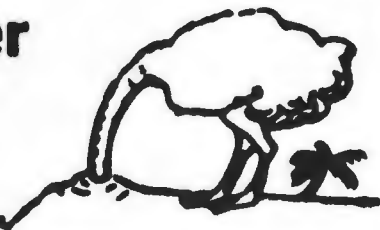
