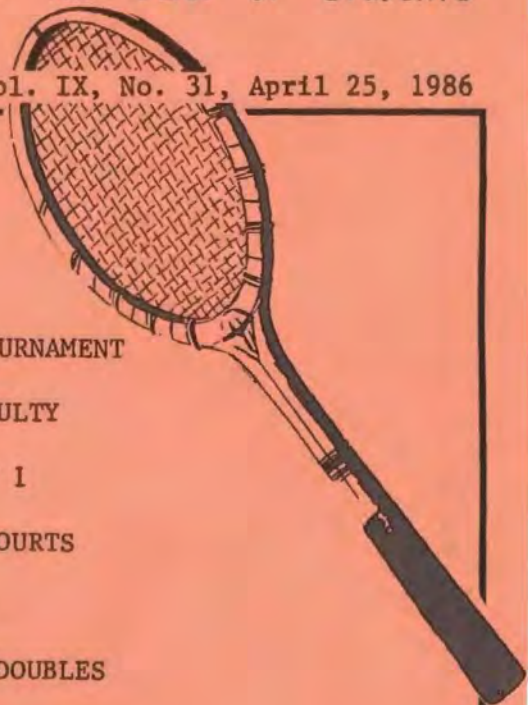

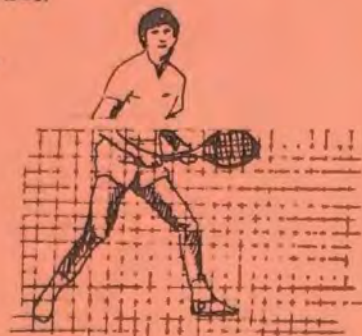

Exam permits will be issued at the business office window Tuesday, May 6 and Wednesday, May 7.

Those students with a -0- balance will be allowed to pick up their permits in the hall.
