Pianist Linda Holzer, Associate Professor of Music at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock was named the 2001 College Teacher of the Year by the Arkansas State Music Teachers Association. Dr. Holzer is an active soloist and chamber musician. She has been heard in concert nationwide, including performances at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts, New York Public Radio Station WNYC-FM, Noon Time Concerts at St. Patrick's Cathedral in San Francisco, and as concerto soloist with several orchestras.

Prior to joining the faculty at UALR, Dr. Holzer, served as an Artist-in-Residence for four seasons with the North Carolina Visiting Artist Program. She has been a featured Artist/Educator in an interview on the *Piano Education Page* web site, and has published articles in *Clavier, Piano & Keyboard*, and the *American Music Teacher*. An alumna of Maine East High School, Holzer holds degrees from Northwestern University, the University of N. Carolina-Chapel Hill, and Florida State University.
