He performs extensively throughout the United States, and currently serves as Associate Professor of Church Music at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree, as well as Master of Music and Master of Musical Arts Degrees from Yale University. His Bachelor of Music degree is from Steson University. He has studied organ with Paul Jenkins, Robert Noehren, and Charles Krigbaum, and harpsichord with Richard Rephann. Dr. Jones was recently named first prize winner at the Bay View, Michigan International Organ Playing Competition. He has been a finalist or runner-up in many international competitions. In addition to his duties at Southern Seminary, Dr. Jones serves as Organist/Choirmaster at First Lutheran Church, Louisville.
