•Apply for an OSF Scholarship

The Ouachita Student Foundation will award 25 \$500 scholarships and nine \$1,000 scholarships for the 1994-95 academic year. To apply, you must be classified as a junior or senior beginning next fall. Applications are available in the lobby of the communications department in Mabee Fine Arts Center, and are due March 11. The Ouachita Student Foundation invites you to apply for membership for the 1994-95 academic year. Students classified as sophomores, juniors, or seniors beginning next fall may apply. Membership applications are available in the lobby of the communications department in Mabee Fine Arts Center. Applications are due March 11 and may be returned to OBU Box 3761 or placed in the box provided in the communications department lobby.

•**The Sophomore Composition Exemption Exam** will be given two times before pre-registration (March 10 at 10:00 am and March 30 at 2 pm in Lile 330). If you will have 59 or more cumulative semester hours at the end of the spring semester, you are required to take this exemption exam before pre-registration for fall classes. Please sign up at the Academic Affairs Office, Grant Hall 102.

•**Changing Your Advisor Assignment**-If you need to change your academic advisor assignment, please do so before March 25. Students majoring in the School of Arts and Sciences should go to the Academic Affairs Office, Grant Hall 102. Music Majors should go to the School of Music Office, MFA 233. Business Majors should go to the School of Business, Lile 239A. Your pre-registration material will be sent to the advisor listed in our computer files. Please be sure that the Academic Affairs Office has your correct advisor assignment on file. Thank you.

•**Degree Plans**-If you are going to have 59 or more hours at the end of the spring semester, you are required to submit a degree plan to your appropriate school dean before pre-registration. (Music Majors - School of Music; Business Majors - School of Business; Arts & Sciences Majors - Academic Affairs Office). Forms may be obtained from the office of your school dean.

•**Last Call for RA Applications**-

If you are interested in applying for an RA position for next year, pick up an application and reference form at the Office of Student Services. If you have an application in hand but don't have it in, please get it in as quickly as possible. Applications and references must be received by April 1, 1994, to be considered. Interviews will follow soon.

•**New Residence Hall News**-Applications for the new men's residence hall will be available beginning March 14 from all men's hall directors and the Office of Student Services. The application also lists the criteria for consideration for the new hall. The application process will conclude April 1. Applicants will be ranked according to scores and the other criteria, and within about one week, students will know whether they have been accepted.

TRAFFIC REMINDER

Please remember and observe the changes in traffic and parking which have come to campus with construction of the new residence hall:

4th Street between Ouachita and Cherry Streets is closed.

Ouachita Street is open to 2-way traffic.

There is a 2-way stop sign at the intersection of Ouachita and 6th Street (by the OBU entrance sign).

Park only on the south side of Ouachita Street (JPAC side) both day and night.

Traffic on 5th Street between Cherry and Ouachita Streets is still one-way. This is being monitored by Arkadelphia Police.

When exiting from the Conger and OC Bailey lots, turn right, go around the student center, and thus avoid the construction site.

Park only in spaces designated for the parking permit issued to you.

Observe the 15 mph speed limit on campus.

Please do not park on Cherry Street.
