SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications for the following scholarships are available in the Financial Aid Office for the 1994-95 academic year:

Hale-Moore Education Fund- Scholarships to be awarded to students from middle income families who plan to attend OBU. Selection is based on need and merit, with preference to Baptists actively involved in church and community. **Deadline: June 30, 1994.**

Orville Redenbacher's Second Start Scholarship- 30 \$1,000 scholarships available to students 30 yrs. old or older at time of application. **Deadline: May 1, 1994.**

AICPA Scholarships for Minority Accounting Students- Merit and need based awards to outstanding minority accounting students who show significant potential to become certified public accountants. **Deadline: July 1, 1994.**

Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship- Scholarships to assist students interested in a teaching career at the preschool, elementary or secondary school level. Applicants must have ranked in top 10% of high school graduating class. Awards are based on academic performance, major field of study, and promise of service as a teacher. **Deadline: June 15, 1994.**
