The Arkansas Symphony Orchestra, under the direction of Robert Henderson, will be presented in concert on Tuesday, October 22, at 7:30 p.m., in Mitchell Hall Auditorium at OBU.

The performance is co-sponsored by OBU, as a part of its Centennial celebration, and the Joint Educational Consortium of Arkadelphia, as a feature of its performing arts series.

The 60-member touring orchestra will perform the "Roman Carnival Overture" by Berlioz, the waltz from Tchaikovsky's "Swan Lake Suite," three selections from Mozart's opera, "Marriage of Figaro," and the "Romeo and Juliet Suite" by Prokofiev.

Vocalists for the operatic selections are Mary Ann Henderson, soprano, and Frederick Fox, bass-baritone.

Since its incorporation in 1966, the orchestra has grown into one of the state's major musical resources. It has had a series of outstanding conductors, including Dr. Francis McBeth, nationally-recognized composer and professor at OBU, who led the orchestra from 1970-73.

Robert Henderson has served as music director and conductor since 1981.


