AMTRAK!

Arkadelphia will become the state's newest stop along the route of the Amtrak Eagle which runs between Chicago and San Antonio, when the northbound train pulls into the Clark County town at 11:15 pm, October 28.

Opening ceremonies for the new passenger service are scheduled at 7:45 a.m., October 29, just minutes before the southbound Eagle pulls into the Arkadelphia station at 7:51 a.m. Amtrak officials, state and city officials have been invited to attend the celebration. The service will come to Arkadelphia on a one-year, trial basis.

The Eagle provides service to Arkansas three times a week, with stops at Texarkana, Malvern, Little Rock, Newport and Walnut Ridge in addition to the new stop at Arkadelphia. Beginning December 16, the Eagle will make daily runs through Arkansas until January 8, to accomodate holiday travelers. After January 8, the service will resume its three weekly runs.

Railway passengers departing from Arkadelphia may buy tickets from the conductor on the train or from Small World Travel Agency, 2905 West Pine in Arkadelphia. The Arkadelphia depot will be maintained by the city, but will be unmanned.
