FACTS IN BRIEF

College Costs Increase in 1985-86

The College Scholarship Service of the College Board annually publishes the average costs of attending college for undergraduate students. The publication includes the following information.

- In the past year, the average cost of tuition and fees at public four-year institutions increased from \$1,126 in 1984-85 to \$1,242 in 1985-86. The average cost of tuition and fees at four-year independent institutions increased from \$5,016 to \$5,418 in the last year.

—At two-year public institutions, the average cost of tuition and fees increased from \$598 to \$659, while at two-year independent institutions the increase was from \$3,404 to \$3,719.

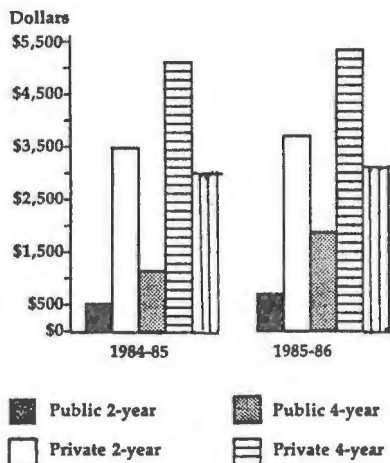
- The average cost of total expenses—including tuition, fees, room, board, transportation, books, supplies, and personal items—ranges from \$5,314 to \$9,659 for resident students.

- The average cost of total expenses for a resident student attending a public four-year institution in 1985-86 is \$5,314. Tuition and fees represent \$1,242 of that amount; room and board, \$2,473. The remaining \$1,599 is for books, transportation, and personal items.

- For resident students at independent four-year institutions, average total expenses amount to \$9,659. Tuition and fees account for \$5,418; room and board costs \$2,781. The remaining \$1,460 covers books, supplies, transportation, and personal items.

The average cost of total expenses for a resident student attending Ouachita in 1985-86 is \$6,100. Tuition and fees account for \$3,150; room and board costs \$1,750. The remaining \$1,200 covers books, supplies, transportation and personal items.
