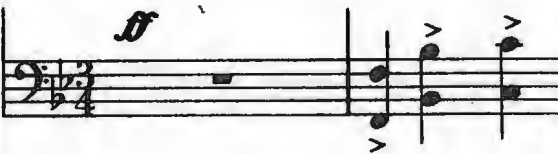

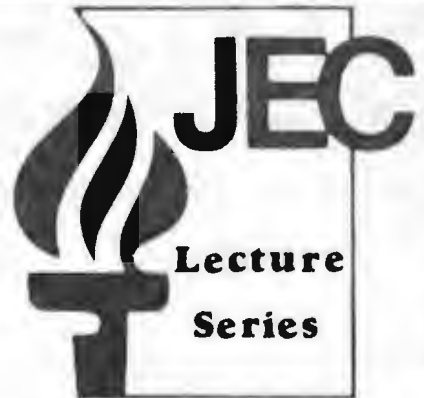
ATTENTION !!




