Ouachita Students Invited to Participate in Shoreline Clean-up

Individual Ouachita students and campus student groups are invited to participate in the 15th annual DeGray Lake Shoreline Clean-up and the second annual Caddo River Clean-up, on Saturday, September 11, beginning at 8 a.m.

The shoreline clean-up will involve a choice of either helping on the DeGray Lake area near Arkadelphia or the Caddo River near Caddo Gap on Arkansas Highway 8. The DeGray Lake helpers may pick up trash bags and receive area assignments at the Spillway Recreation area.

A free lunch and door prize drawings will be held for all volunteers at DeGray from 12 noon until 3 p.m. at the Highway 7 recreation area pavilion.

For those persons and/or groups interested in the Caddo River clean-up, efforts will begin at 8 a.m. on September 11 at Arrowhead Canoe Rental at Caddo Gap on Highway 8. The clean-up will conclude at dark. Arrowhead and Wright Way Canoe rental will donate free canoes, paddles, life jackets, trash bags, and shuttle service for the clean-up. Free camping and lodging is also available for the clean-up participants.

The Corps, in cooperation with local sponsors, is also sponsoring a free breakfast and catfish dinner for the individuals and groups involved in the project.

Worried About a Friend?

His office is located in the Student Center, and appointments may be made by calling Student Services at 245-5220. Mr. Hendley comes to Ouachita from a private practice in El Dorado.
