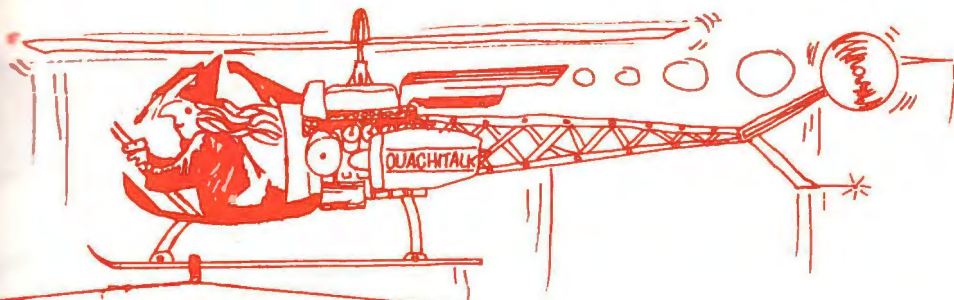
LET'S GO SKATING
