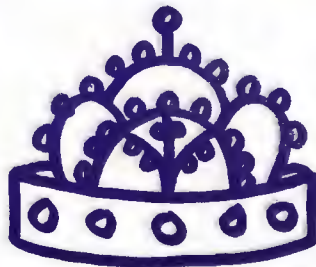
Chapel
