#### THE ARTISTS

Denise Duren Edds graduated from Ouachita Baptist University in 1981 with a bachelor's degree in music education. While at Ouachita she studied voice with Mrs. Frances Scott and participated in Ouachita Singers, opera workshop, and Sigma Alpha Iota.

Stephen Edds studied voice with Dr. Paul Hammond while attending Ouachita and finished in 1980 with a bachelor of music education degree. He was involved in Ouachita Singers, opera workshop, Singing Men, and was a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Both have received master's degrees in music from North Texas State University where they participated in opera theatre and worked with Joan Dornemann, vocal coach and assistant director for the New York Metropolitan Opera. At NTSU Mr. Edds studied with Dr. Edward Baird, and Mrs. Edds studied with Laurel Miller and Virginia Botkin and was awarded a teaching fellowship in voice for three years.

Mrs. Edds has appeared as a guest soloist in numerous churches and has been a guest soloist for performances of Handel's Messiah in Texas and Arkansas. She is currently teaching voice in Sheridan, Arkansas.

Mr. Edds has also appeared frequently as bass soloist for Handel's Messiah. He has served in churches in North Texas and is now on staff at First Baptist Church, Sheridan, Arkansas.

The accompanist, Robert Lindley, graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with a bachelor's and a master's degree in organ. Mr. Lindley was the first prize winner of the statewide organ competition sponsored by the University Presbyterian Church of San Antonio, Texas and has made numerous appearances in oratorios and recitals as well as solo organ recital work. He is currently serving as the organist and music assistant at First Baptist Church of Pine Bluff.
