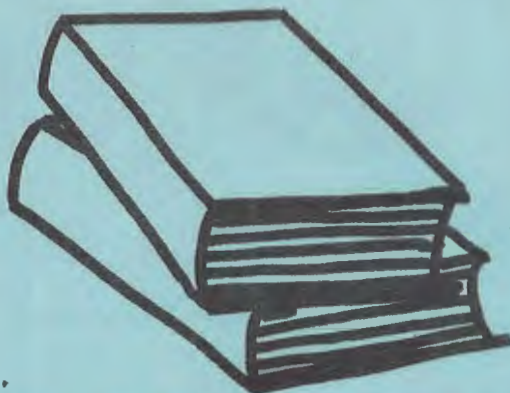

Books look alike, and someone else's book can often be picked up by mistake. Put your name, I.D. number, and dorm in your books so they can be easily identified.

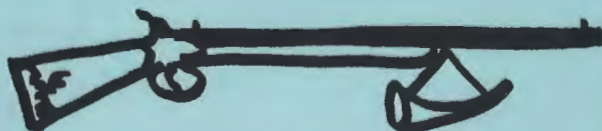

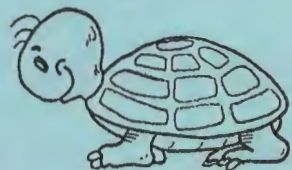

Chapel this week will be led by Mr. Gary Rand, a musician from Chicago, Ill.

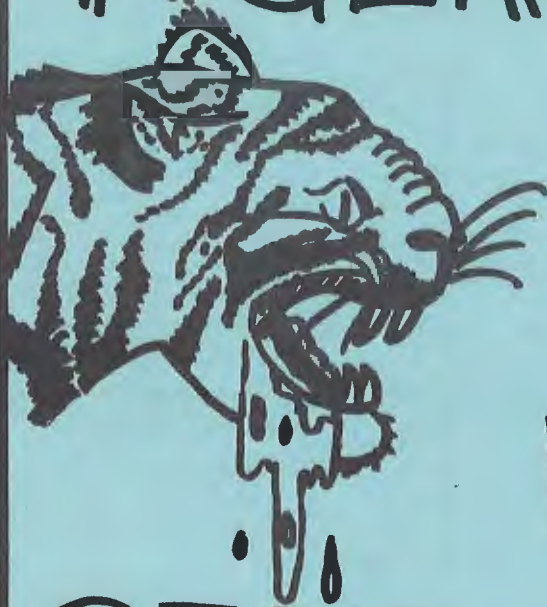


The women of Pi Kappa Zeta are proud to present:
