



## Studying-The Scribe

- Common Hebrew Word for Reading- קרא (qra)
  - Heavy connotations for reading out loud or crying out
  - Different than reading silently
- "Less than 10% of the men and virtually no women" in biblical times would have the ability to read and write as modern-day believers do
- Ezra 7:10- שרֹז (darosh) Searching the Scriptures

"For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel."



## Studying-The Scribe

- Modern Day Applications-
  - Read and Study the Word!
  - Memorization of Scripture
    - Writing or saying them out loud repeatedly
    - Mnemonic Devices and Illustrations
  - Academic Resources and Commentaries





#### Hearing-The Prophet

Jeremiah 1:9- "Behold, I have put my words in your mouth."

- The spoken word of Jeremiah, Isaiah, Jonah, and all the other prophets were given the same authority that we place on the written word
- The expectation was for this spoken word to impact the hearer's life
- Common Hebrew Word for Reading- קרא (qra)
  - Used by prophets, priests, and other individuals



## Hearing-The Prophet

- Modern Day Applications-
  - Preachers
    - Sunday School Teachers
    - Anyone that reads the Word of God Aloud
  - Meditating over the Word
  - Audio Bibles

#### Seeing-The Monk

John 1:14- "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us"


- Mentoring in the Bible- Moses, Elijah, Paul, and Jesus
- The Mindset of a Christian Monk-
  - Did not have to do with the monastery by necessity
  - Living out their faith and being "one who seeks God single-mindedly"

Athenagoras- Many in the Early Church were "utterly unable to describe the value of our doctrines in words" but they proved their faith "by their deeds"



#### Seeing-The Monk

- Modern Day Applications-
  - O Mentors!
  - Living out one's faith and "Imitating Christ" in all things
  - Serving Others in Love
  - Worship and Prayer
