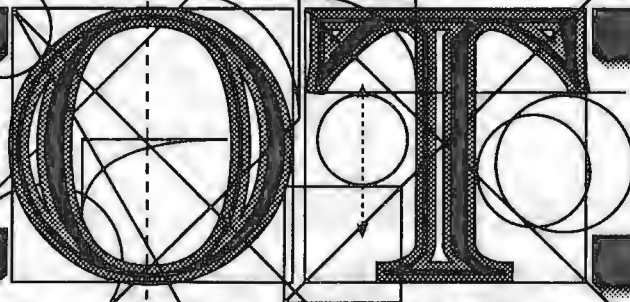

participate by setting up a display for Parent's Day. The

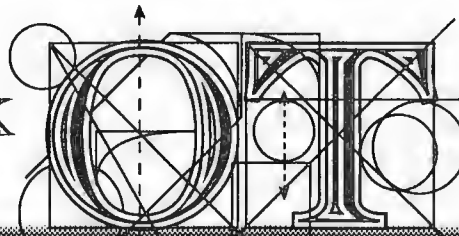

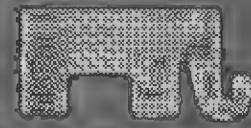

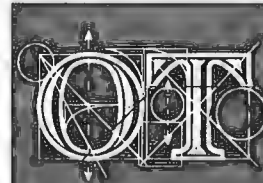
