CHECK LIST



DORMITORY CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

1. All residents must check out with the Head Resident or RA on duty. All graduates should check out immediately following graduation.
2. ROOM and BATHROOM should be completely cleaned, sanitized, swept, dusted, mopped, debris removed and all windows cleaned before asking the Head Resident or RA to check you out. (There is a minimum \$25 charge for dirty rooms).
3. There will be NO SUMMER STORAGE AVAILABLE. All personal belongings must be removed from the dorms. Special permission may be given by the Head Resident to store a limited amount of boxed labeled items in designated storage areas. Special labels are available from the Head Resident. OBU HAS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ITEMS LEFT IN STORAGE.
4. ALL trash and unwanted items must be taken outside to the dumpsters. Trash bags may be obtained from the Head Resident. DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING IN THE HALLS!
5. ALL keys must be returned to the Head Resident or RA at checkout (this will be noted on the checkout form). New lock installation (\$50) will be charged to the resident if keys are not returned.
6. You must COMPLETE and SIGN the checkout form. If checkout is not completed properly there will be a \$20 charge assessed and the housing deposit will be forfeited. Any damages will be assessed by the Dean of Students Office and Maintenance and charged to your account.
7. If you decide not to return to OBU this fall, you must notify the Dean of Students Office no later than July 1st to receive your \$50.00 housing deposit. NOTE: Housing deposits will automatically be applied to any outstanding bill).

YOU MUST:

- a) check out of the dorm properly
 - clean room and bath as mentioned above
 - have RA or HR complete the checkout form

 - turn in all room keys you have
 - sign and date checkout form
- b) clear your account with the Business Office
(Note: Housing deposits will automatically be applied to any outstanding bill.)
- c) understand any damages or extra cleaning costs will be assessed to your account.

FAILURE TO CHECK OUT PROPERLY WILL RESULT IN A MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$20.
