- All residents must check out with the Head Resident or RA on duty. All graduates should check out immediately following graduation.
- ROOM and BATHROOM should be completely cleaned, senitized, swept, dusted, mopped, debuts removed and all windows cleaned before asking the Head Resident or RA to check you out. (There is a minimum \$25 charge for dirty rooms).
- 3. There will be NO SUMMER STORAGE AVAILABLE. All personel belongings must be removed from the dorms. - 7. If you decide not to return to OBU this fall, you must notify the Dean of Students Office no later than July lat to receive your \$50.00 housing deposit. NOIE: Housing deposits will sutematically be applied to any outstanding bill).
