YELLOW CURB ZONES ARE NOT FOR LOADING!

Just a reminder to those who are loading and unloading in front of dormitories. If the curb is painted yellow, it is a NO PARKING ZONE. That means no parking at any time. The reason for yellow curb zones is to satisfy Fire Code Regulations to keep the area clear at all times seven days a week, 24 hours a day. The fine for leaving a car in a yellow zone is \$20. The amount of time is not a factor. It is possible for more than one \$20 ticket to be placed on a car if it remains in a no parking zone for a period of time. In such case the car would most likely be towed away at the owner's expense. This is stated in the Tiger Handbook. Those who park in these areas are taking a chance on receiving one or more \$20 fines.
