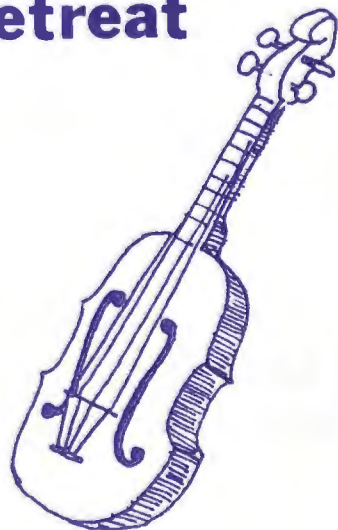

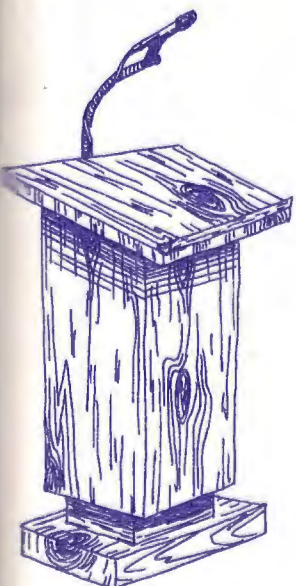

THE OUACHITALK SPOTLIGHTS AN OUTSTANDING PROFESSOR;

Dr. Raouf Halaby graduated from OBU with his BA in English in 1968. He received his MSE in 1970 and his Ed. D. from East Texas State in 1973. He came back to Ouachita to teach English in 1973 and now holds the rank of Associate Professor. He and his wife, Rachael, have two sons, Ramsey and Ryan.

Dr. Halaby has published scholarly articles in both educational journals and daily newspapers. Topics range from linguistics to Mid-Eastern affairs. He has presented papers at professional organizations at the University of

Texas, Detroit and other places. He attended a National Endowment of the Humanities seminar at the University of Minnesota, where he studied Ethnic Literature.

Presently, Dr. Halaby is writing a biography of a Lebanese doctor who practiced in Oklahoma.

Last weekend, Dr. Halaby was invited to the White House to attend a seminar and briefing on Arabic-American affairs.
