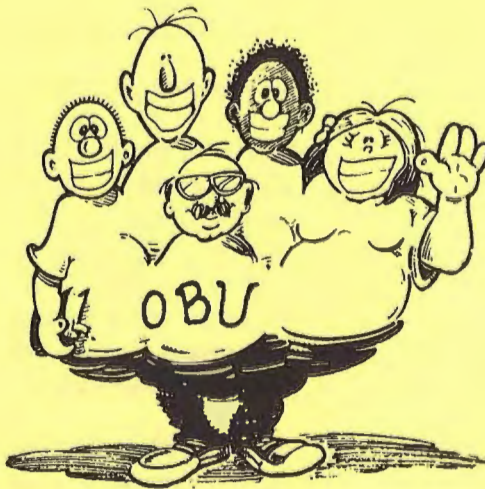

Student Contests with CASH AWARDS!

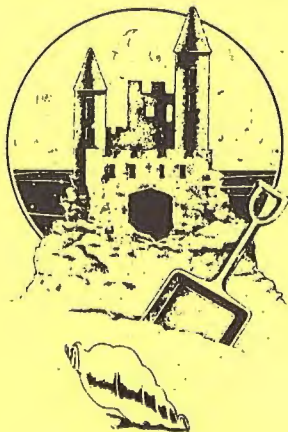
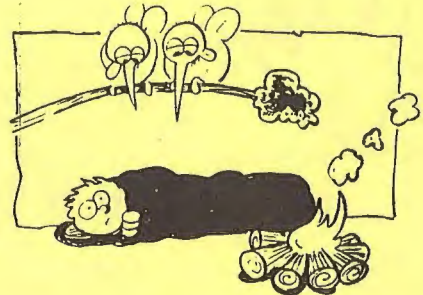
In preparation for Alcohol Abuse Awareness Month in April, Student Services is sponsoring two contests which offer cash awards:
