Thase Daniel (from front cover)

In achieving her status as one of the world's ten leading wildlife photographers, the late Thase Daniel, a 1927 graduate of Ouachita, found her subjects as nearby as the Arkansas wetlands and as far away as Africa, Antarctica, the Galapagos Islands, Greenland, India, Nepal, Australia, Mexico, New Zealand, Sri Lanka and South America.

Her pictures have sold to collectors and leading magazines such as *National Geographic*, the *Audubon Society*, *National Wildlife*, *Ranger Rick*, and *Field and Stream*. The pinnacle of her accomplishments came with the 1984 publication of "her" book, *Wings on the Southwind*, which featured her photographs of Southern flora and fauna.

Riley-Hickingbotham Library is now the home of Daniel's entire collection of slides and field notes. The roughly 52,000 slides, which were donated shortly before her death in 1990, represent the best of almost a quarter-million slides taken during her two-decade career.
