OUACHITA STUDENTS EXCEED GOAL FOR RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE



Two weeks ago students came out in record numbers to give blood at the American Red Cross Blood Drive. One hundred and sixteen donors sat graciously in the banquet rooms while they gave blood.

Sara Miller, director of the Diamond Valley Blood Services District for the Red Cross, said, "We had set a two day goal of 100 units for Ouachita. We hoped that we would be able to receive our goal, but many times our drives fall short of our goals." Ouachita's blood drive numbers had been down the last couple of years, a trend that can be felt across the

state. "I am so thankful for Ouachita's students and their willingness to give blood," added Miller.

The Red Cross held blood drives at the University of Central Arkansas and at Harding University last week, but the numbers fell short of what took place at Ouachita.

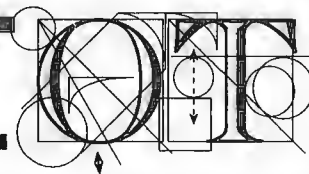
