At that time patients who suffered from sud wounds were treated with sedatives and prayer. Very few survived. Surgeon Daniel Ha Williams was on call when Cornish was brought to Chicago's Provident Hospital. Dr. William decided to do what no other surgeon had ever done -- open Cornish's chest and operate on heart.
