"In 1893 a young, husky Chicago street fighter sustained a knife cut, puncturing an artery a fraction of an inch from his heart. At that time patients who suffered from such wounds were treated with sedatives and prayer. Very few survived. Surgeon Daniel Hale Williams was on call when Cornish was brought to Chicago's Provident Hospital. Dr. Williams decided to do what no other surgeon had ever done -- open Cornish's chest and operate on his heart.

"Working with six colleagues, Dr. Williams operated. The patient lived. It was the first open heart surgery and paved the way for today's heart by-pass surgeries which save thousands each year."
