

NEW DEGREE PLAN POLICY

- 1. Students with 74+ hours projected for the end of a regular semester, or transfers with 29+ hours, will not be allowed to participate in the COURSE PREFERENCE SURVEY until an approved plan is on file in our office.
- Students submitting degree plans to their dean's office must now sign a statement of responsibility for the plan, acknowledging that they have checked the requirements and are following the approved curriculum.

The multiple year scholarships pay for tuition, fees and books, in addition to a \$100 monthly subsistence allowance.


