Scholarships

The deadline for OBU Scholarships for the 1993-94 academic year is FEBRUARY 15, 1993. Applications are available in the Financial Aid Office, Mitchell 301. Students currently receiving awards from the OBU Scholarship Committee MUST reapply for renewal of their scholarship. Students receiving Presidential, Scholastic Excellence, McPherson, or Leadership Scholarships must maintain required grade point averages for continuance of their scholarships; therefore, an application for renewal is not necessary. All students are encouraged to apply by the deadline.

Financial Aid

1993-94 applications for federal and state financial aid are available in the OBU Financial Aid Office, Mitchell 301. Students are encouraged to file if they are interested in receiving a grant, work-study, or a student loan during the coming school year. (During the fall semester, recipients of federal aid were required to file an application through their OBU box.)
