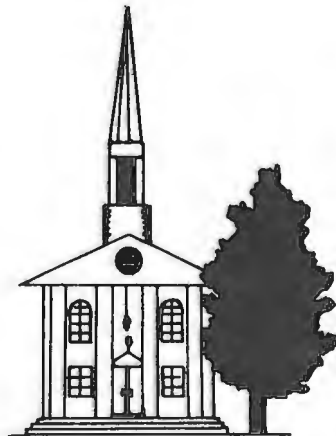

IF YOU PLAN TO PARTICIPATE IN MEN'S RUSH, PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION

There are a few rules which must be followed if you want to participate in rush at Ouachita. The rules are designed to guarantee that you will emphasize the importance of academic life in your college career, to insure your physical safety if you should decide to pledge a club, and to provide fairness to the existing clubs as they make their plans for the rush parties. No exceptions will be made to the following regulations:

- NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO SIGN FOR ANOTHER PERSON.
- YOU MUST SIGN A HEALTH RELEASE FORM AT THE SAME TIME THAT YOU SIGN UP FOR RUSH. IF YOU FAIL TO SIGN THE RELEASE FORM, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN RUSH.
- OUR HEALTH SERVICE MUST CERTIFY THAT YOU HAVE A RECORD OF A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION ON FILE IN THAT OFFICE. IF YOU DO NOT, YOU WILL HAVE TO HAVE A PHYSICAL BEFORE RUSH BEGINS, OR YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO THE PARTIES. IF YOU CURRENTLY KNOW THAT YOU HAVE NOT SUPPLIED OUR HEALTH SERVICE WITH A PHYSICAL, WE ADVISE YOU TO TAKE CARE OF THIS MATTER AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
- IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN RUSH, YOU MUST HAVE AT LEAST A 2.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND HAVE PASSED AT LEAST 12 HOURS DURING THE PAST SEMESTER.
- YOU MUST PAY A \$2.00 RUSH FEE AT THE TIME THAT YOU SIGN UP. DO NOT PLAN TO SIGN UP UNTIL YOU PAY THE FEE.
- ACADEMIC AND HEALTH RECORDS WILL BE CAREFULLY CHECKED, AND YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED IF YOU ARE INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN RUSH.
- SIGN UP BEGINS ON MONDAY, JANUARY 31. SIGN UP ENDS ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 10. YOU MUST SIGN UP IN THE STUDENT CENTER OFFICE, LOCATED ON THE THIRD FLOOR, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8.00 A.M. AND 5.00 P.M., MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
