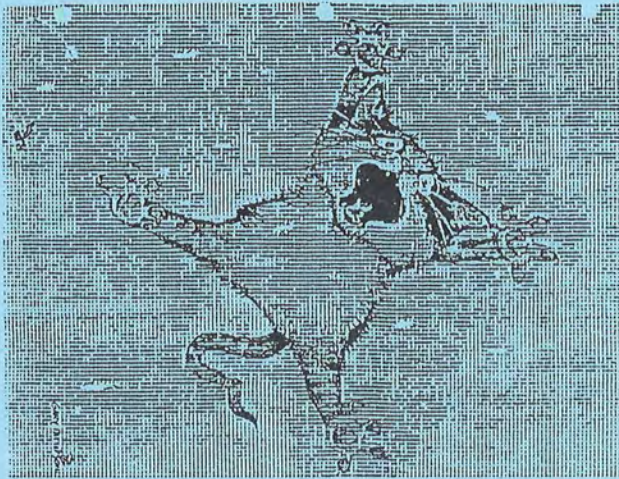

- The following scholarship applications and guidelines are available in the Financial Aid Office:
 - The Arkansas Press Women are presenting a scholarship to a deserving student majoring in journalism or communications. Deadline: March 1, 1995.
 - The Arkansas Public Health Association is presenting a \$500 scholarship to a freshman student and a \$1,000 scholarship to a sophomore, junior, or senior student. Applicants must be Arkansas residents, enrolled in or planning to enroll in a field of public health and have at least a 2.5 GPA. Applicants must also demonstrate financial need. Deadline: March 16, 1995.
- The Association of Arkansas Counties is currently accepting applications for its 1995 Scholarship program. Applicants must be a child, grandchild, adopted child, or stepchild of a current or retired county employee of Arkansas; must major in government or related course; must have a financial need; must show academic merit; must be a high school graduate of the state of Arkansas; and must attend college or graduate school. - **REMINDER:** The OBU Scholarship deadline is February 15, 1995. Applications are available in the Financial Aid Office.

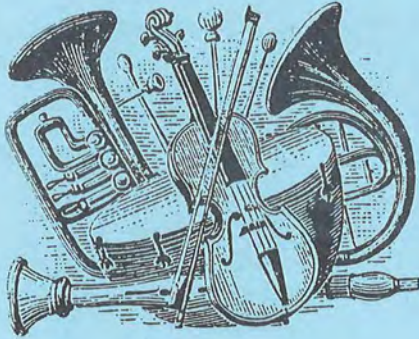
