Ouachita faculty and staff honored for combined 730 years of service

ARKADELPHIA, Ark.—During Ouachita Baptist University's a



nnual Faculty/Staff Banquet, 39 faculty and staff members were honored for a combined total of 730 years of service at the university. Dr. Johnny Wink, Betty Burton Peck Professor of English, was recognized for 45 years of service.

“We’re here this evening primarily to notice people,” said Ouachita President Ben Sells at the annual event. “We want you to know that you matter and your work matters. It’s important that we notice and honor one another.”

Wink, this year’s longest-serving honoree, first joined Ouachita in 1973 as an assistant professor of English. Wink holds a B.A. in English from the University of Southern Mississippi and an M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Arkansas.



“When an alumnus tells me their ‘Ouachita story,’ it always includes the name of a faculty or staff member and a specific way that person invested in the alumnus. Because of Dr. Wink’s tenure and impact, I’ve heard many Johnny Wink stories,” Sells said.

“I’ve met people from all over the world here because Ouachita is a school that is missionary in nature. I’ve had students who believe in all kinds of things and worked with faculty that have a rich variety of

views,” Wink said. “Instead of being a uniform and grey place, it’s been a colorful and vivid place. It just never stopped being that.”

Wink currently teaches classes in advanced grammar, creative writing, Latin, composition and banned books. Over his 45 years at Ouachita, Wink has taught a wide variety of classes including mythology, Charles Dickens, Jane Austen, world literature and linguistics.

“You’re learning things along with your students because you don’t know everything. Or at least you don’t if you’re me, and you’ve got lots of things to learn,” Wink noted. “There’s a lot of that spirit at Ouachita, wanting to be learners as well as teachers.

“Get as much as you can out of this place, because it has so many wonderful things to offer,” Wink said. “Learn as much as you can in as many disciplines as you can, and see where that leads you. It could lead you into something of a very pragmatic nature, but sometimes it’ll just lead you into joy. Life at its best ought to be about wonderment and joy at God’s creation.”
