ARKADELPHIA, Ark.—Ouachita Baptist University will present the Ouachita Women's Chorus and Ouachita Singers in concert Tuesday, Oct. 19, at 7:30 p.m. in McBeth Recital Hall. The concert is free for students and the public.

Both choirs will perform songs based on the themes of faith, joy, hope and imagination.

Ouachita Singers will perform "I'll Be On My Way" by Shawn Kirchner; "Geistliches Lied" by Johannes Brahms; "Sing Out My Soul" by Marques L.A. Garrett; "Pure Imagination" by Leslie Bricusse and Anthony Newley, arranged by Matthew D. Nielsen; and "Cantate Domino" by Jan Pieterszoon Sweelinck.
